**Time:** During school hours (7:30am - 11:00am)

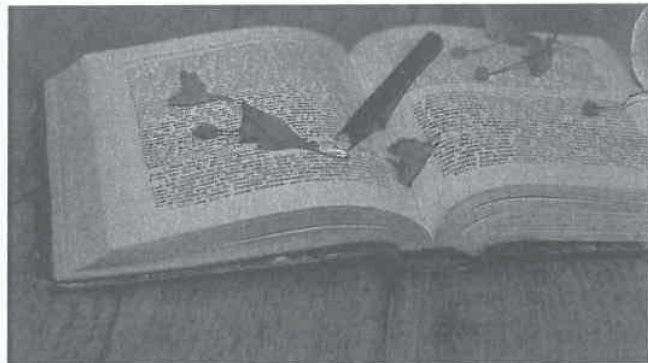
What to Bring and Wear:
